

2018 IGBMC International Summer Internship

The *Institut de Génétique et de Biologie Moléculaire et Cellulaire* (IGBMC) is a major European center for biomedical research. The institute is located near Strasbourg, in the heart of Europe, close to the German and Swiss borders. Strasbourg hosts the second largest university in France, and houses the Council of Europe and the European Parliament. It is a historical and picturesque city, with a cosmopolitan environment and a vibrant cultural life.

In the summer of 2018, the IGBMC will provide talented undergraduate students from around the world the opportunity to spend 6-8 weeks alongside IGBMC researchers. Students will carry out short research projects and address scientific questions in a dynamic environment. Projects will center around areas of life sciences such as development, transcription, cancer, neuroscience, biochemistry, structural biology and bioinformatics.

This is the chance for students who are interested in future graduate studies to meet with scientists from various disciplines and gain hands-on experience at the bench. The working language is English.

Eligibility:

The Summer Internship Program is for undergraduates who have completed at least two years of university and first year master students. Candidates need to be enrolled in university until the end of the internship. Applicants are expected to have an excellent academic record.

To Apply:

- A curriculum vitae.
- An official signed certificate from the university indicating the degree in progress (Bachelor or Master), the exact title of the degree (eg: Biology), the registration date of the degree, the current year of the degree and the predicted graduation date of the degree (validation date of the diploma and not the end of the university year). IMPORTANT: to be eligible, students in the final year of their bachelor will need to validate their diploma after the end of summerinternship
- A copy of the Bachelor diploma for M1 candidates
- A list of coursework and grades.
- A cover letter describing the applicant's research interests, career goals, scientific methods of interest and the date the candidate can start (June 1st or July 2nd)
- A list of up to five projects, by order of preference.
- A copy of passport or ID card

While filling the application you will be asked to list up to five projects, by order of preference, from the list indicated on the website <u>IGBMC-summer-internship-open-positions</u>.

Application Deadline: January 29th 2018 (noon Paris time)
